Characteristics

Genus & Species: Dianthus hybrida

Protection Status: U.S. Plant Patent 21,397. COPF Open.

USDA Zone: USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).

Bloom: Deep salmon flower which look just like little rosebuds. Free flowering over a long perid.

Repeat blooming.

Bloom Period: Early season – Fall.

Foliage: Glaucous, blue green foliage. **Habit:** Compact mounding habit 6" x 4".

Propagation: Tip Cuttings. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Full sun, well-drained soil.

Additional Comments: No vernalization required for blooming. Flower stems are sturdy and do not flop. Dead

headed and fed regularly to encourage fast repeat blooming. Attracts bees and butterflies.

Uses: Containers, Borders, Mass Landscape Planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

4.5"- Quarts: 10-16 weeks from a 128 plug (spring planting).

Closest Variety: D. Garden Spice[®] Series Key Differences: ✓ Rosebud Zone 5 hardy vs. Zone 6 hardy.

✓ Rosebud glaucous foliage vs. green-glaucous foliage.

✓ Rosebud no vernalization vs. vernalization required.
