Characteristics

Genus & Species: Dianthus hybrida

Protection Status: PP 21,418. COPF Open. **USDA Zone:** USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).

Early season wonderfully fragrant large double blooms, magenta in color carried on sturdy Bloom:

stems. Repeat blooming.

Bloom Period: Early season - Fall.

Foliage: Glaucous, blue green foliage. Habit: Compact mounding habit 6" x 4".

Propagation: Tip Cuttings. License required for propagation.

Culture: Full sun, well-drained soil.

Additional Comments: No vernalization required for blooming. Flower stems are sturdy and do not flop. Dead

headed and fed regularly to encourage fast repeat blooming. Attracts bees and butterflies.

Uses: Containers, Borders, Mass Landscape Planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

4.5"- Quarts: **8-10 weeks** from a 128 plug (spring planting).

✓ Sherbert glaucous foliage vs. green-glaucous foliage.
